

Dear Member,

The Board of Directors of the Holmen Rod and Gun Club consider member safety and security to be the highest priority of operating our club. As time progresses and our membership grows, improvements must be made to insure that your experience at the club remains enjoyable.

We are currently in the process of updating our camera network and entry system. Upgrading these items will allow us to verify that all shooting activities are conducted only by members and their guests. It will also allow us to quickly identify violations of range rules and destruction of club property.

Starting in 2020, the entry gate will be equipped with a radio-frequency identification card (RFID) reader. Members will be issued an RFID card when purchasing a membership. This card will be unique to you, and should be safe-guarded as such. Life members will be issued a card after updating their information for the following year. Please watch the website and Facebook page for more information on this process.

The increased security measures come at a significant cost to the club. Membership fees for 2020 will be increasing to support the objectives of keeping the ranges safe and secure. Annual membership fees will be \$100/year and life membership fees will be \$1,000. Any annual memberships purchased on or after December 1, 2019 will be at the new membership fee. Any life memberships purchased on or after January 1, 2020 will be at the new membership fee.

The club is operated and maintained entirely with volunteer help. You are encouraged to get involved and attending a club meeting is the best place to start. Club meetings are held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of the month on Holmen Rod and Gun Club grounds.
